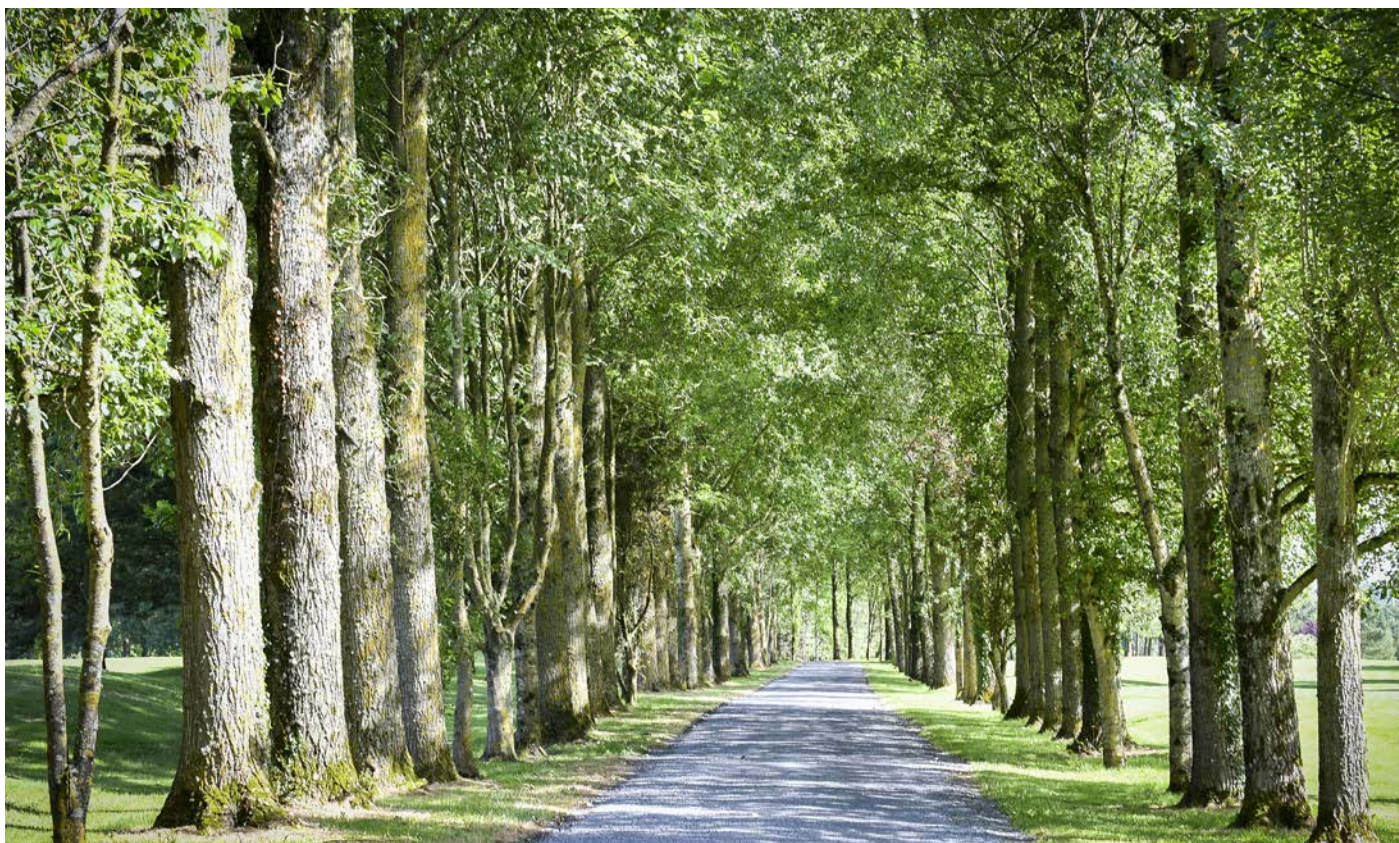

With a history dating back to 1180, Kilkea Castle captures the mystical charm of a 12th Century majestic Castle with the overwhelming allure of timeless sophistication and style. Once the medieval stronghold of the FitzGerald's, Earls of Kildare, the Castle was built by Hugh de Lacy.

This family-run estate recently underwent a €35 million renovation that redefines luxury. Kilkea Castle is located in Castledermot, only one hour drive from Dublin, along Ireland's Ancient East and set on 180 acres of its own wonderful woodland, gardens and golf course.

Kilkea Castle Golf Course is situated in the magnificent landscape of the 12th Century Castle. The 18-hole par 70 championship Parkland Course was part of the expansive restoration and transformation of the Kilkea Castle Resort. The 6,200-meter well-groomed golf course has been brilliantly designed by Jack McDaid and Jim Cassidy, with every attention to detail applied.



The course design takes full advantage of the River Griese, a natural water hazard flowing through the Castle grounds and estate, which golfers will encounter at almost every hole.

Two lakes have also been integrated into the course design, increasing the overall difficulty of this royal and ancient game.

The most stunning course feature is the unique topography, which allows the splendour of the Castle to be viewed from every fairway.

Kilkea Castle Golf Course offers various golf memberships, all accompanied with a practice putting green, a fully stocked golf shop, as well as a Clubhouse Bar and Restaurant.

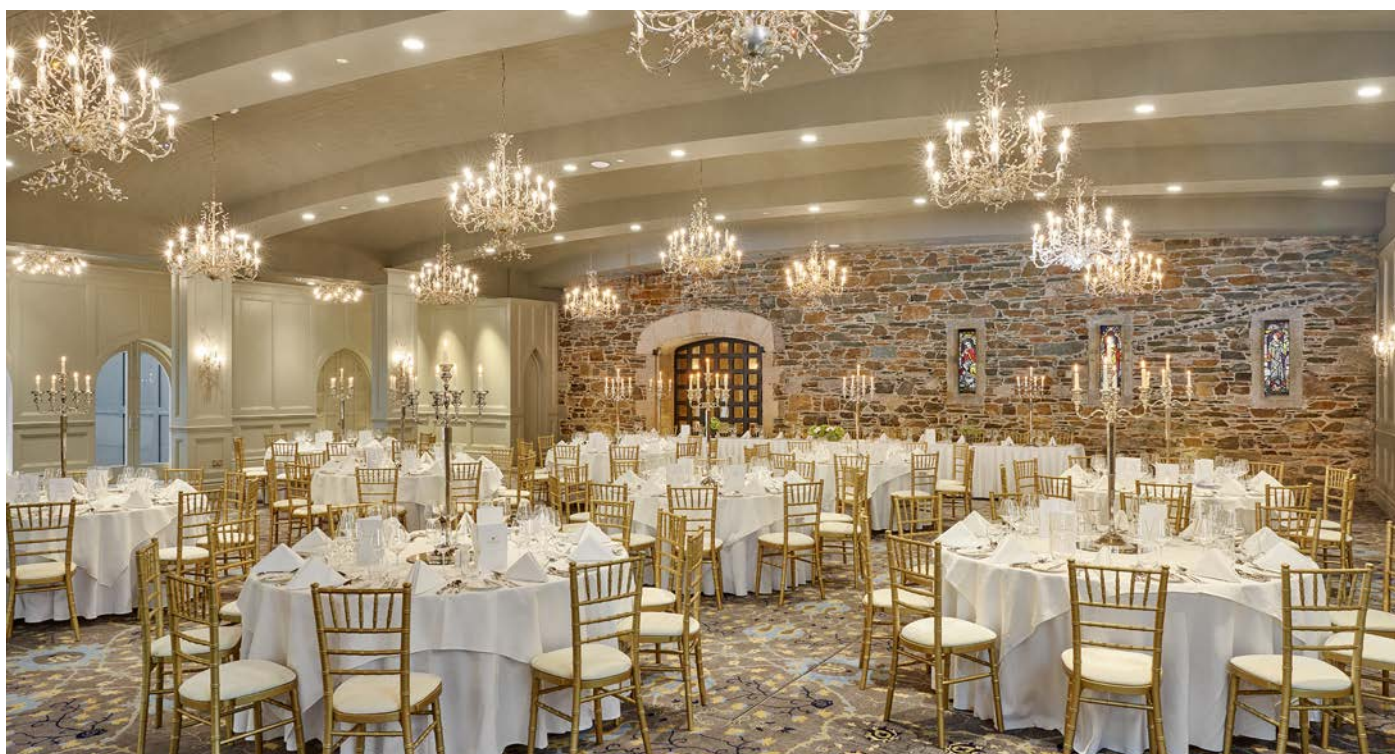


Weddings

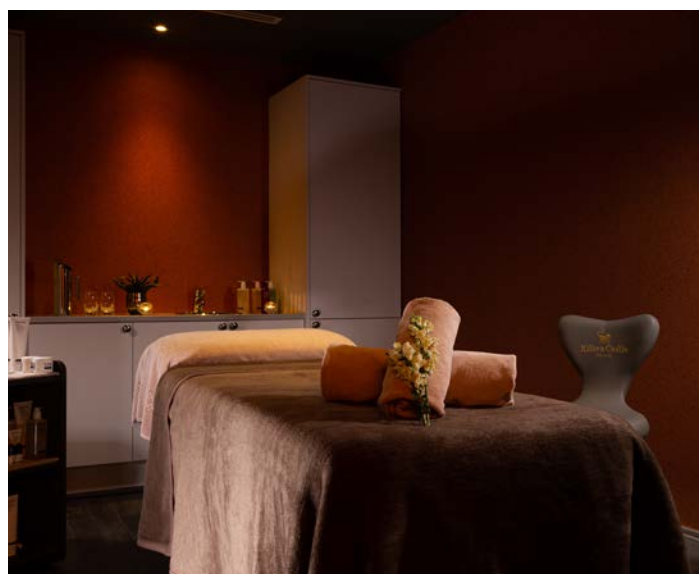


The Spa Reception
